DEPARTMENT NEWS

Our graduate design students will be participating in UCLA School of Theater, Film and Television's 11th Annual Design Showcase West on June 8th. NEWS FOR FACULTY AND STAFF

Change in the way leaves are calculated - As of February 2013, all non-academic UCSD employees began accruing leave based on a Factor Leave Accrual Table, rather than on a Monthly Leave Accrual Table. Factored leave accrual means that sick and vacation leave accruals are calculated based on a factor accrual rate. [Translation: you earn the same sick and vacation days as in the past, per year, but they are not equally distributed monthly any longer. They are now apportioned out every pay period based on the number of hours worked in that pay period.] More here.

If you are eligible to apply for an "I", <u>follow these directions</u>.
