

Graduate Student Funding Policy: MFA Program

Master of Fine Arts students entering Fall 2020 and beyond:

The Department of Theatre & Dance will directly pay the University for resident, non-resident, or foreign tuition for each student. Non-resident students are expected to claim residency prior to fall of their second year. Non-resident tuition is not covered for students beyond their first year. The Department will also pay resident and foreign tuition for year 2 and fall and winter of year 3 for each student.

Though no additional funding is guaranteed, the majority of our students have the opportunity to work as TAs/GSRs/Readers as needed by the department.
