

Theatre Minor

The Theatre and Dance Department offers a minor in Theatre. The minor provides students an opportunity to explore their area of interest in acting, directing, playwriting, history, stage management and/or design. Several Theatre and Dance undergraduate productions are held each year giving students the chance to perform on stage and/or assist in these productions. These productions are performed in our Theatre District, which is shared with the Tony award-winning La Jolla Playhouse.

Minors can be declared online at TritonLink. No audition required.

All courses taken for the minor must be taken for a letter grade and only grades of "C-" or better will be accepted.
